ACCESS TO CLINICAL AND DENTAL CARE

Our student health clinic saw 74% more students than the previous year. The clinic—managed by Carilion Children's—serves all Roanoke City Public Schools (RCPS) students through sick care, well checks, immunizations and school and sports physicals. A pediatric nurse practitioner is on site weekdays year-round,

supported by a registered nurse. Additionally, 289 Fallon Park students received preventive oral and dental healthcare, including exams, cleanings, x-rays, fillings and extractions.

MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT -

A Tree Planted Collective supported Fallon Park with 7 mental health clinicians who saw students both in groups and individually. Together with parents and school counselors, they identified each child's unique needs and tailored services accordingly. Clinicians partnered closely with the school system during times of transition, offering training and direct assistance to faculty and aides. These efforts helped strengthen the school's capacity to respond to student needs and created smoother, more effective processes for staff and students.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT -

We hosted many opportunities for Fallon Park families to connect and share enriching experiences. "LIFT Up Tuesday" events provided free children's books and activities to foster healthy behaviors, including a healthy cooking workshop, family yoga class, creative storytelling and puppet-making workshops and a visit with animals from the Mill Mountain Zoo! Free hot meals, produce, groceries and cooking supplies were provided by Feeding Southwest Virginia.







HEALTH RESOURCES AND EDUCATION

Carilion Clinic provided a bilingual community health worker who helped families apply for Medicaid and financial assistance, worked with individuals to set and reach health goals and assisted with accessing housing, transportation and food.

Carilion and Delta Dental health educators taught evidence-based, interactive curricula to students, families and staff during and after school.

Freedom First financial wellness counselors from the Financial Empowerment Center continued to be a vital resource for Fallon Park families, offering guidance and support through financial transitions. The team remains deeply committed to helping families build stronger financial futures—one conversation, one goal, one step at a time. They continue to work with Fallon Park families to reduce debt, create spending plans and build credit.
